The BEST Location for Your Pellet Stove

PREPARE Your Space

Your pellet stove can't be installed on carpet or any flammable surface. You can choose between using a fire proof pad or installing permanent non-flammable flooring. Each stove has varying clearance space between the stove and combustibles, but all of them require remarkably little space. For example, the Countryside has a one inch sides and back clearance space!

Be Safe. INSTALL Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Detectors

The use of a pellet stove requires a smoke alarm and a carbon monoxide detector in close proximity to the stove. You may already have detectors installed that will suffice, depending on the placement of your new stove. Do a quick check, and remember to replace batteries twice a year.

INFORM Your Insurance Provider

Simply give your homeowner-insurance provider a call to let them know the stove you are buying. Many agents will require a brief visit to the home before and/or after installation. Some policies will charge a nominal fee for the addition of a pellet stove. Don't be surprised if your agent is excited about your choice in MagnuM brand, due to our high safety standards.

CHECK for Cash Back, Rebates, and Tax Credits

Many cities and counties are working toward more efficient and environmentally friendly ways for residents to heat their homes and replace outdated appliances. There may be savings, rebates, or swap out programs available in your community. Check with your city, utilities, cooperatives, county, and state. If there are federal-level tax credits available, as have occurred in the past, you can check with your tax preparer. We'll pass any tax credit information along on our blog and social media which you'll need at tax time.

PURCHASE Your Pellet Stove and Save Half the Cost of Shipping
